Selmore Baptist Church is an autonomous church that is voluntarily a part of the Southern Baptist Convention. We adhere to our church covenant and the Baptist Faith and Message 2000 which outlines the primary doctrine we require for membership and service. Although it does include the primary doctrine, we understand that there are varying beliefs on many secondary issues that make up the church body. Regarding secondary issues, there is an absolute truth, however, we are all working to find that and often are in different places as we search for that truth. This includes your beliefs regarding where you are at on the scale of free will or pre-destination. We may even change some of those secondary views as we travel through life. We strongly believe in practicing Proverbs 27:17 which states "As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." As a member, we ask that you extend grace as you openly and humbly discuss these issues with your brothers and sisters. We are also a church that strives to fulfill Matthew 28:19 to "Go and make disciples of all the nations.." and we reject any belief that impedes that mission.
